From Victim to Survivor...

"Veronica" and her 10 year old son, "James" came into shelter, both had been victims of years of physical, sexual and emotional abuse. The husband/father had passed away and his family kicked Veronica and James out of their home leaving them with nowhere to go. While the family was in BATP shelter, Veronica attended every class the agency had to offer and was the first resident to successfully complete a parenting class provided by a partnership with BACODA. Child Protective Services also became involved with the family and provided counseling for James to overcome his abusive past. BATP assisted Veronica and James with school enrollment, and James was given school supplies and a new backpack. Veronica also received counseling from the BATP therapist. The Special Needs Case-worker worked diligently with this family and provided Veronica with information on services offered by other programs and agencies that could help as well. Veronica eventually began receiving disability income and assistance for housing. She and James moved out of shelter and into their own place; a brand new start with a bright future free of violence. This family had a painful situation to overcome but they were successful through their determination for a better life and the combined efforts of the many caring staff, volunteers and agency partners. *Veronica and James are no longer victims but... survivors!*
