## November food drive!

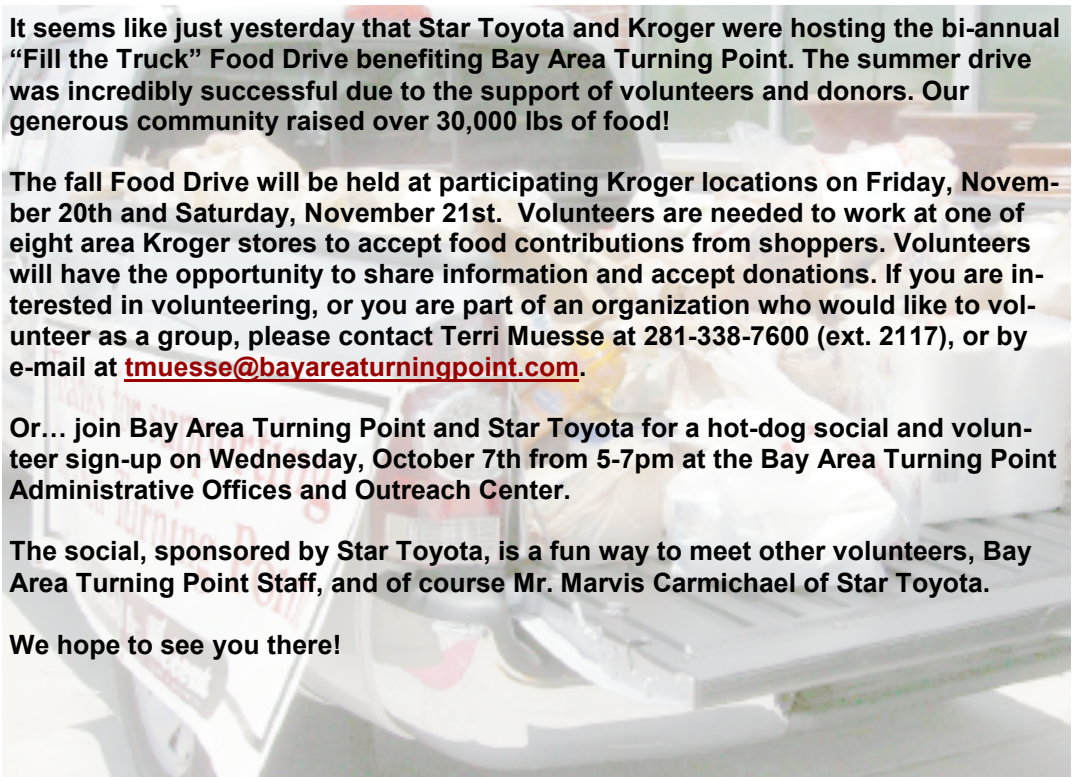


